SARGENT CRABAPPLE

Malus sargentii



Number of trees: 1 Bark ID color: PURPLE

Profuse clusters of small, white, fragrant flowers in spring are followed by 1/2" red berries that persist into winter and attract birds. New leaves are light green, later turning a darker green.

WASHINGTON HAWTHORN

Crataegus phaenopyrum

Bark ID color: YELLOW

White spring flowers are followed by $\frac{1}{4}$ red fruits that stay on the tree into winter. Thorny stems produce reddish-purple leaves that change to dark green in summer, then to orange, scarlet, or purple in fall. This tree has a high wildlife value.

NORWAY SPRUCE

The stiff, dark green needles are retained on the tree for several
years before dropping. Cones 4"–6" long are formed around
age 30. The seeds and tender foliage are eaten by birds and
mammals. Plant 6'–13' apart for windbreak.

CRAPEMYRTLE



Number of shrubs: 2 Bark ID color: RED BAG

The striking flowers have wrinkled petals like crepe paper in colors of white, pink, or red. They bloom from late spring to fall. The leaves in summer are dark green, changing in fall to yellows, oranges, and reds. Exfoliating thin gray bark exposes a smooth, varied-colored underbark ranging from brown to gray.


